## FileYourTaxes.com announces the 2004 Tax Season Beta Site

Today, FileYourTaxes.com announced that the Beta site containing the Federal and portions of certain supported states' tax preparation software was made available for the review and comments of the taxpayers and the tax preparer community.

Timur Taluy, VP said "We opened the Beta site approximately 3:00 AM in Friday and our servers detected user activity within a couple of hours. This is such an encouraging sign, indicating that our customers are seriously interested in our product and its evolution." Timur continued to say "Our system is built for the OnLine filer without hastily modifying an existing software product that was intended for another purpose. Therefore, such customer feed back is very valuable, and well appreciated by us. Much of our development is based on the feedback we obtain from our customers since our software is specifically designed for their use." The FileYourTaxes.com Beta system is not intended for the calculation of live tax returns.

FileYourTaxes.com will again participate in the Free File Alliance for the 2004 Tax Year with greater contributions and penetration in to the Marketplace. Free File Alliance is a consortium of software companies in agreement with the Internal Revenue Service, contributing at no charge a certain portion of their return construction and eFiling capabilities to the taxpayers, based on criteria selected by each company. In aggregate, all these companies intend to cover a minimum of 60% of all American Taxpayers. Last year, this actual percentage greatly exceeded the targeted percentage, and yielded approximately 2.8 Million eFiled Federal returns, filed free of charge, as well intending to assist increased number of eFiled state returns.

Timur said "We provide a wide spectrum of services. Besides being most proficient in the personal income tax arena, we are simultaneously preparing to assist the employer-payer community in eFiling their W-2s and 1099s during approximately the same time window as the Personal Income Taxes. Normally information returns, due at the end of February may be eFiled by the issuers as late as end of March. This great benefit is for those who eFile. Similarly, we hope that the proposed legislative Federal solutions will soon allow later eFiling and payment option for, and reward the Personal Income Tax filers as well."

Referring to the FileYourTaxes.com payroll systems, Timur said "Our XML based 941/940 project is underway. As was announced in early November this year, our joining of forces with CFS, who is a well known provider of paper based payroll and information returns, will provide significant added capability to the users of this Market segment. We anticipate that the combined filing will become available soon in 2004."

Taluy continued to point out the capabilities of FileYourTaxes.com by saying, "We believe that we are the first and only OnLine eFiling company that provided Beta sites for the benefit and response of the taxpayer community and the tax industry. We are very proud of this program. FileYourTaxes.com is the cutting-edge technology firm in the tax preparation and eFiling industry. We believe that we are the only remaining industry member from the original IRS OnLine Pilot Program. Our system design philosophy and extensive server farm will allow us to bring about many more such innovative amenities to our users."
