Atila M Taluy announced the FileYourTaxes.com website completed the 1997 personal income tax electronic filing season on October 15, 1998. The results of the operation of FileYourTaxes.com showed continued success with an increase of approximately 15 times the number of returns filed last year. This overwhelming increase was accompanied with an extremely low reject rate, based on the known industry average. Taluy said, "Even though the tax jurisdictions will not accept electronically filed returns any longer this year, the taxpayers can still file their taxes through our FileYourTaxes.com site, mail them in the form of paper returns".

Work is continuing on developing of a robust data integrity check system, which should further reduce the reject rate of the electronically filed returns. This effort is part of the comprehensive renovation of the entire system

The IRS is changing the name of the Customer service Number (CSN) to E-file Customer Number (ECN). The information provided previously, regarding CSNs is valid with the exception of the name change to ECN.

The accommodation of ECNs, and the ACH Debit mode of payment will give FileYourTaxes.com a unique position in the next tax season. It was mentioned that the IRS presented these two innovations for the first time this year and that the ECN is a pilot program of the IRS that will also be available through FileYourTaxes.com. Direct Deposit will be offered.

Plans are underway to make a test web site available by the first part of December 1998 in response to the requests made by members of the Media, and other interested parties. The time and location of this FileYourTaxes.com site will be announced in a future release.
